Criteria for shortlisting candidates for admission to PhD programme for Semester 1, 2024-2025

Short-listing criteria for admission to Ph.D. programme (BMZ) in Semester 1, 2024-25 is as follows. Candidates with national fellowships allowing them to avail funding for the programme are eligible to appear in the interview subject to satisfying Institute's qualifying criteria. Candidates, who have appeared for Ph.D. interview at the Centre twice and did not qualify, shall not be shortlisted as per Center's policy.

ANNEXURE 1 (A)

Minimum qualification criteria (Employee & Employer) for Part-Time PhD applicants

1. Employees of Public Sector Undertakings or Government Departments or Research and Development Organizations.

2. Minimum qualification for these candidates is the same as for full-time candidates, except that the requirement of qualifying in a national examination is waived.

3. Employees of Non- government (Private) organizations are eligible if the organization satisfy the following:

a) Number of employees in the organization is at least 25 or more.

b) The organization should be registered for at least 5 years.

c) The organization should be relevant to CBME and the research area interested.

4. Part-time candidates from outside NCR (or at a radial distance of more than 50 km from IIT Delhi), there is a minimum residency requirement of 6 months. DRC/CRC/SRC may specify a higher residency requirement based on the courses recommended as well as the background.

5. The part-time candidate of both Government and Private Organizations should have Employee ID of the Organizations and should have work experience of at least one year. Their employment should also be valid for another 3 years from the date of PhD enrolment.

6. The candidate will produce a valid NOC from the employer as per Institute format.
