a) Qualifying degree as B.Tech/B.E. in any of the following disciplines:

Chemical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Engineering Physics, Mechanical Engineering, Energy Engineering

Note:

- (i) For part-time candidates with B. Tech./ B. Engg./ M.Sc. as a qualifying degree, a minimum one year of experience as on **25th June, 2025** is required along with the above-mentioned requirements in (a) or (b) except GATE Score.
- (ii) Part time candidates should produce No Objection Certificate from Employer as per IIT Delhi proforma at the time of interview.
- (iii) Full time sponsored candidates seeking admission to a MS (R) programme must submit a "Sponsorship Certificate" on a proper letterhead from the appropriate authority in the organization clearly stating the following:
 - for the period of their studies in the programme, the candidate would be treated as on duty with usual salary and allowances; and
 - that they will be fully relieved and granted study leave for a minimum period of 2 years.
- (iv) Requirement of qualification in GATE / National Exam is waived for the following categories of applicants:
 - Currently registered students in Centrally Funded Technical Institutes (CFTIs) pursuing B.Tech./ B.E., M.Sc. who are
 in their last semester, and have CGPA of 8.0 or above on a 10-point scale (or 80% aggregate marks, if marks are the
 primary mode of evaluation). Such students must obtain a CGPA of 8.0 or above at the time of graduation, and before
 they formally register for the programme;
 - Graduates of CFTIs, B. Tech./ B. Engg./ M.Sc. with a final graduation CGPA of more than 8.0 on a 10 point scale (or 80% aggregate marks);
 - M.Sc. graduates from IITs with CGPA 8.0 or above.
- (v)The shortlisted candidates will have to appear for an interview between 14th May and 16th May, 2025 in ofline mode. The exact date and time will be intimated in due course.
