Criteria for shortlisting candidates for admission to MS(R) Program for semester I, December cycle 2024-2025, M.S. (Research) in "Healthcare Technology" by CBME

The selection process 2024-25 includes two stages, Stage-1 includes screening of application as per selection criteria I or II followed by Stage-2 in person interview as per III.

Separate waiting list shall be made for MBBS/ BDS, BVSc, BAMS, BHMS, BPT, BPO/MD,MS,DM,MCh, MDS,MPT and BPharm/ MPharm, if required.

Offline (in-person) interview of shortlisted candidates is tentatively scheduled on 11/12/2024.

Annexure 1.1: requirements for part-time candidates.

II. Part time with no stipend:

- Case 1:
 - Qualifying degree with 60% or more marks.
 - Qualified national level exam in respective domain.
 - NOC from the current employer or proof of practice.
- Case 2:
 - Qualifying degree with 55% or more marks.
 - Work experience with more than 5 years of experience in industry, government/private hospital or clinical practice (Post Graduation and Super Specialty will be counted in the experience).
 - NOC from the current employer or proof of practice.

III. Interview Process:

- Both full time and part time candidates will be shortlisted as per criteria I or II as applicable and will undergo an in-person interview at CBME.
- Interview panel (consist of standard PG program selection process at IIT Delhi) with following additional members:
 - Two external experts (preferably one clinical expert from Government/Private hospital & one Biomedical Industry expert, Experts with strong research background and proven track record).

Annexure 1.1

Minimum Qualifications for admission to Part-time and Sponsored (Full-time) M.S.(R) Programme:

1. Only employees of Public Sector Undertakings or Government Departments or Research and Development Organizations or Private Industries (approved by Faculty Boards) are eligible for admission to these programmes.
2. Employees of only those organizations which are located within 50 Kilometres radius of IIT Delhi are eligible to be considered for admission to part-time M.S.(R) programme.
3. The minimum experience (Full Time) required after qualifying degree and as on date of registration is as given in Table 2.
4. Minimum qualification for these candidates is the same as for full-time candidates except that the requirement of qualifying in a national examination is waived.
5. Sponsored (full-time) candidates seeking admission to a M.S.(R) programme on the basis of study leave, must submit a "Sponsorship certificate" on a proper letterhead from the appropriate authority in the organization clearly stating the following:
 - a. for the period of his/her studies in the programme, the candidate would be treated as on duty with usual salary and allowances, and
 - b. that he/she will be fully relieved and granted study leave for a minimum period of 2 years

6. Part-time candidates are required to submit a "No Objection Certificate" on a proper letterhead from the appropriate authority in the organization, clearly stating the following:
 - the candidate is permitted to pursue studies on a part-time basis
 - that his/her official duties permit him/her to devote sufficient time for studies
 - that he/she will not be transferred to any other place during the period of study
 - that his/her official duties permit him/her to attend required classes as per the Time Table of IIT Delhi.
7. Please note that all part-time and sponsored candidates will have to go through an interview or selection process.

Template of this NOC is available on the IIT Delhi PG admissions website. Kindly note that lack of confirmation and clarity on one or more of the above points in the NOC may make prevent the applicant's application being processed, even if he/she qualify in the interview/screening.
