All shortlisted MS(R) candidates (based on GATE score, CFTIs and part-time/sponsored) will be interviewed online. The interviews will be conducted between May 20-23, 2025.

Candidates will be asked to present their original documents (along with NOC/sponsorship-certificate in IIT Delhi prescribed format for part-time/full-time sponsored applicants) during the interview, failing which, they shall not be allowed to appear for the selection process.

#Note:

- (a) For colleges where the percentage (P) system is followed, candidates should check the cut-off criteria in GPA (G) using the formula: $G=P/10$.
- (b) For GPA with scales of other points, a linear interpolation will be used, i.e., $10 \times G_x / X$ where G is the GPA on 10 point scale and G_x is the GPA on 'X' point scale.
- (c) Rounding-off the GPA to the nearest decimal will not be allowed.

*Currently registered students in Centrally Funded Technical Institutes (CFTIs) pursuing B.Tech./B.E., who are in their final year, and have CGPA of 8.000 or above (on a 10-point scale). Such students must obtain a CGPA of 8.000 or above at the time of graduation, and before they formally register for the MS(R) program (80% aggregate marks, if marks is the primary mode of evaluation).

**Candidates applying for part-time MS(R) must satisfy the following experience criterion, along with fulfilment of other criteria in PG admissions brochure such as residing within 50km of IIT Delhi, should be able to get leave for courses etc.)
