## MS(R) in Healthcare Technology, Centre for Biomedical Engineering, IITD

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

1. What are the eligibility criteria for MS(R) in Healthcare Technology, at CBME IITD?

You would need to have one of the following degrees (MBBS, BDS, BVSc, BAMS, BHMS, BPT, BPO, BPharm, MD/MS/DM/MCh, MDS/MPT/MPharm) with at least 60% marks or 6.0 CGPA on a 10- point scale. In addition, you would also need to have a valid scorecard for NEET (PG), AIIMS(PG), PGI(PG), or any other national-level PG exam in your respective specialty.

2. How much is the validity of the national level PG exam you have qualified in your respective specialty?

The student should have qualified for the exam.

3. Is there any age limit for applying for this course?

No.

4. What are the shortlisting criteria for interviews beyond eligibility?

The shortlisting criterion will be decided by the Centre Research Committee (CRC) as per institute norms. Students will be tested for their aptitude & subject knowledge through an interview, to ascertain their preparedness for the M. S. (Research) Programme.

5. Does the JAM or GATE score count?

For this particular course, GATE/JAM is not valid.

6. Am I eligible for MS(R) in healthcare at CBME, IITD, if I appear for the NEET/GPAT/Other national eligibility exams after the application or interview date?

No. The prerequisites for this program are NEET (PG), AIIMS (PG), or another national-level exam with a valid scorecard.

7. Is clinic immersion available for the registered candidates?

Yes, a 2-3 month clinical/Industrial immersion applies to all registered MS(R) students. During this period, the registered students can identify a problem, validate the research hypothesis, and work on that collaboratively during their research thesis.

8. I am a regular working professional elsewhere, Can I join this program?

Yes, regular working professionals can be enrolled as sponsored part-time candidates.

9. What are the eligibility criteria for part-time students?

The eligibility criteria and interview selection standards are the same for full-time students. In addition, part-time candidates must submit a "No Objection Certificate" (NOC) on a proper letterhead from the appropriate authority as per IITD requirements. Check here.

AI in medical imaging and AI in Medical Informatics

13. When does the admission process start?

The admission process will be according to institute rules twice a year. The application form will be out in April and October each year.

14. How much stipend will the full-time registered students get?

Along with the base stipend as per IITD norms, enrolled MS(R) students will get an honorarium from the project advisor. Few selected candidates after a critical evaluation by CRC will also get the clinical duty remuneration.

15. Is there any stipend for part-time candidates?

No

16. What is the timeline for a part-time student?

It's 3 years. A part-time student would also need to fulfil the credit requirement as a full-time student.

17. How much is the course fee and stipend for a full-time and part-time course?
