

Short-listing Criteria for admission to M.Tech Programme (2025-2026)

Full Time M.Tech

Category	Minimum Qualification
General and EWS	GATE score of 500 and Minimum of 60 % Marks or CGPA of 6.0 ^{5.0} on a scale of 10 (aggregate of all years) in B.Tech. or equivalent degree.
OBC	GATE score of 450 and Minimum of 60 % Marks or CGPA of 6.0 on a scale of 10 (aggregate of all years) in B.Tech. or equivalent degree.
SC/ST and PH	GATE score of 300 and Minimum of 55 % Marks or CGPA of 5.5 on a scale of 10 (aggregate of all years) in B.Tech. or equivalent degree.

Note:

- (i) All the shortlisting candidates will be called for a written test. Final selection will be based on written test score and GATE Score.
- (ii) For Applicants from IIT with CGPA more than equal to 8.00, Gate score is not mandatory.
- (iii) Sponsored and part-time candidates should meet the minimum institute criteria with regard to experience. They need not have valid GATE score.
- (iv) Candidates in the final year of their programmes and who expect to complete all their qualifying degree requirements before the third week of July 2025, are eligible to apply for admission. For short-listing purposes, their performance till the preceding semester (preceding year if their programmes are year based) would be considered, but their admission would be provisional, subject to their meeting the minimum eligibility criteria after their final qualifying examination results are announced.
