**Criteria for shortlisting candidates for admission to PhD programme for Semester 2, 2022-2023**

Short-listing criteria for admission to Ph.D. programme (BMZ) in Semester 2, 2022-23 is as follows. Candidates with National fellowships allowing them to avail funding for the programme are eligible to appear in the interview subject to satisfying Institute's qualifying criteria. Candidates, who have appeared for Ph.D. interview at the Centre twice and did not qualify, shall not be shortlisted as per Center's policy.
