

Prof. Sanjay Sarma

Prof. Sanjay Sarma is the Fred Fort Flowers (1941) and Daniel Fort Flowers (1941) Professor of Mechanical Engineering at MIT. He currently serves as the Vice President for Open Learning at MIT, constituting of the Office of Digital Learning, the MIT Integrated Learning Initiative and the Abdul Latif Jameel World Education Lab. As Director of the MIT alliance with Singapore University of Technology and Design from 2010 through 2012, Prof. Sarma developed and implemented a forward-looking engineering and design curriculum. He was also the co-chair of MIT's Taskforce on the Future of Education.

Prof. Sarma has authored more than 200 academic papers in computational geometry, sensing, RFID, automation, CAD, learning engineering, the science of learning and education reform. He is the recipient of numerous awards for teaching and research, including the MacVicar Fellowship, Business Week's eBiz Award, and InformationWeek's Innovators and Influencers Award.

He holds a bachelor's degree from the Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur, a master's degree from Carnegie Mellon University, and his PhD is from the University of California at Berkeley.
