

### IIT Delhi, Technopark inaugurated at Sonipat >

In an effort to boost innovation and research, the extension campus of IIT Delhi, Technopark was formally inaugurated at Sonipat on April 3.

Chief Minister of Haryana Mr. Manohar Lal Khattar was the Chief Guest on the occasion. Dr. Satya Pal Singh, Minister of State, HRD and Mr. Ram Bilas Sharma, Minister of Education in Haryana government were also present.

The centre that will gradually emerge as an epicentre of academic and industry fusions is aimed to become a platform where people from a broad spectrum of scientific and industrial community can collaborate in multi-disciplinary areas.

Situated at the Rajiv Gandhi Education City (RGEC), the Technopark is a state-of-the-art convention centre with an auditorium of seating capacity for around 500 persons, two lecture halls with a seating capacity for 100 persons and two conference rooms with the latest audio visual conferencing equipment for video projection and live streaming.



In an effort to bolster research and broaden the education on design, a new Department of Design was formally inaugurated at IIT Delhi on March 28. The Director of IIT Delhi, Prof. V. Ramgopal Rao, was the Chief Guest on the occasion. The Director also announced the new Bachelor of Design program which will start from next year onwards.

### CoE for Research on Clean Air

In an effort to promote scientific research on clean air issues and provide sustainable solutions to the problem of air pollution, a Center of Excellence for Research in Clean Air (CERCA) was inaugurated at IIT Delhi on February 16.

The Center was formally inaugurated by the Lt. Governor of Delhi Mr. Anil Baijal, it has been set up with the help of Mr. Arun Duggal, an alumnus of IIT Delhi who has agreed to extend a generous financial assistance for the CERCA research programme.


The Center will be a platform for undertaking multidisciplinary research projects by the faculty of IIT Delhi, especially focused on the study and resolution of air quality issues in Delhi and NCR region. Besides providing scientific information to policy makers this will also give feedback on the effectiveness of various pollution management programmes.








### A day with an Alum: Visit to Dalmia Bharat Ltd.





















- A 2 member delegation from Ahilia University, Kingdom of Bahrain visited the Institute on February 8.


